



PACKING & PACKING LIST

LUGGAGE INFORMATION

Included in this packet are colored luggage tags to use to label your campers bags. They are color-coded by age group. Please be sure to label all luggage so it can be delivered to the right campers.

If you have more than one camper please take care not to confuse your luggage tags and to attach the correct tag to the corresponding camper's luggage.

WHAT TO PACK

For packing, we recommend that the Taste of Tavor and 2-week long session use 1 duffel bag and one backpack. All other campers can use 1 trunk and/or duffel bag and backpack.

The average trunk size is 32x18x11.
The average camp duffel is 29x15x12.

When packing, we request that you help your camper choose clothing that is respectful and appropriate, be sure to pack together so you both know what is coming to camp.

Campers need clothing for 10-days. Laundry service will be provided at no charge (does not include Taste of Tavor). Camp Tavor is not responsible for clothing or any other item lost or damaged while at camp or by the laundry service.

We recommend simple, inexpensive, sturdy clothing and strongly recommend **labeling everything!** Sewn-in or iron-on labels are the most dependable, permanent, and legible way to make your camper's clothes identifiable.

Choose clothing that is respectful and appropriate, and be sure to pack together with your camper so you both know what is coming to camp and what should be going home. Camp Tavor will make every effort to keep campers and their belongings together, but we have no lost and found. Labeling is the best way for us to be able to get lost items home to you if we can.
